

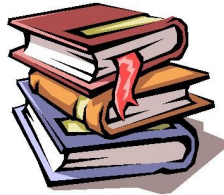

Scot's Pledge in the Library

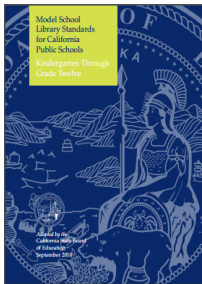
Highlands High School Library Media Center is open to students, parents, and staff.

- ◆ Students and Parents may check out **up to 5 books** with a **two weeks** Loan period. 5 cents a day late fee.



- ◆ Over 1,200 Electronic Books are available to everyone at anytime via the Internet and the school password.
- ◆ **Nooks** are available for student and staff check out for **1 week and require a signed parent permission form** (for students) **before checking out.**

Parents, please visit the library to have an account created if you wish to check out library materials. The cost of **lost books will be placed on your account and a note placed on your child's record.** All fines must be cleared before the end of the school year.
